

The digital SAT Suite offers **more flexibility** for schools and districts to determine when to administer in-school assessments to meet the needs of students and educators.

Digital SAT Suite

What's staying the same

- ✓ The digital SAT Suite will continue to measure the knowledge and skills that matter most for college and career readiness
- ✓ The digital SAT will still be scored on a 1600 scale, and no concordance is required with the current paper and pencil exam.
- ✓ The digital SAT will still be administered in a school or in a test center with a proctor present (not at home)
- ✓ Students will still have **free**, **world-class practice resources on Khan Academy**[®].
- We'll continue to support all students, including those who need accommodations on test day

What's changing

- Students will take the SAT Suite of Assessments on a laptop or tablet.
- The SAT will be shorter about two hours instead of three.
- ✓ Students and educators will receive scores faster in days, not weeks.
- Calculators will be allowed on the entire math section.
- ✓ The digital SAT will be more secure and flexible.
 Each student will get a unique test form, and states, schools, and districts will have much more flexibility for when they administer the digital SAT.



Multi-Stage Adaptive Testing vs Item Level Adaptive Testing

	Multi-Stage Adaptive Testing (MST)	Item Adaptive
Test Delivery	Sets of questions (called modules)	One item at a time
Adaptive	Based on how students perform in the previous module	Based on a student responds to each question
Navigation	Students can review items within a module	Students are not able to go back to a question
Test Length	Supports shorter test lengths	Supports shorter test lengths
Examples	GRE, digital SAT	ACCUPLACER, SBAC, NWEA - MAP, NCLEX

Module 1



Students see a broad mix of questions.


Module 2

Students see a mix of questions but targeted — more higher difficulty or more lower difficulty depending on achievement demonstrated in first module.



Features include:


- A guided experience for room setup and a short proctor script

As part of the digital readiness check, have your students complete either a test preview or a full-length practice test.



Enhancements to educator reports include:


- Aggregate Score Reports versus Student-Level Score Reports
- Run aggregate performance reports by administration and season
- Selection of an individual grade, ALL grades (NEW), or most common grade combination
- Ability to customize the fields displayed in a Roster report
- New Knowledge and Skills Report to inform curriculum and instruction.
- Revised Skills Insight tool which includes exemplar items




BigFuture

- NEW Mobile app only available to students age 13 and over that take a College Board assessment in-school.
- Used to access scores



Students complete an online fee waiver request form


All approved students receive fee waiver benefits and see their status in MySAT when they sign in to their College Board account


